SUMMARY: Company A pushed off into the attack at 0545. A Co. met very light resistance until they were within 300 yds of Objective. There they received heavy MG fire. Third Platoon was hardest hit. At 0745 Able had moved to about 250 yds from Objective, but are meeting very stiff resistance from enemy well dug in behind bunkers. Baker Co. was alerted at 1315 hours to move into the attack after Able had hit very stiff resistance and were pinned down. After heavy fighting the Objective was secured at 1615 hours. Able

and Baker Companies started digging in and preparing defenses for night security. Able Company tied in with Charlie on the left and Baker on the right. Baker tied in with Able on the left and George Company on the right. Able and Baker Companies received small arms and mortar fire up until 2400 hours. Total casualties; Able 3 KIA, 32 WIA; Baker 2 KIA, 1 WIA.
